80 % chance of rain.

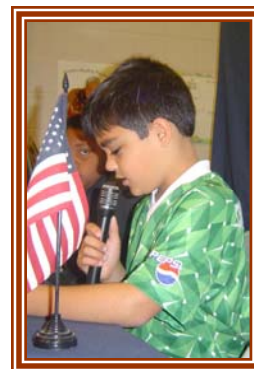
Tuesday – High 74 Low 67 |

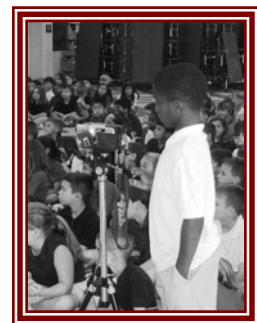
